Scheduled Activities

- 9 Boating on the Bay**—SIGN-UP REQUIRED at the activity tent. **1** Cruise the Bay with Captains Yancey and Jimmy aboard the *Jenny S* to learn about Bay critters, read charts, and enjoy a 45-minute cruise! Must be age 10+ to participate.
Cruises at 1:00, 2:00, and 3:00.
- 11 Experience on Crab Creek**—SIGN-UP REQUIRED at the activity tent. **1** Pending proper conditions. Must be age 12+ to participate. **Alternate activity** includes seining and learning about water quality on Crab Creek and runs every 30 minutes, first come first served.
Canoeing available at 1:00, 2:00, and 3:00
- 22 Learn to Tie a Fishing Fly**—SIGN-UP REQUIRED at the activity tent. **1**
Lessons at 1:30, 2:00, 2:30, and 3:00.
- 23 Dissection! Menhaden & Oyster Experiment**—SIGN-UP REQUIRED at the activity tent. **1** Dissect menhaden and oysters with Heather from our oyster restoration team. How DO oysters filter so much water? Not suitable for guests with shellfish allergies. Must be age 12+ to participate (8+ with an adult).
Offered at 1:00, 2:00, and 3:00.
- 24 Create an Oyster Filter**—SIGN-UP REQUIRED at the activity tent. **1** Design and create your own oyster filter and learn how oysters effectively filter dirt from water!
Shows at 1:30, 2:30, and 3:30.
- 18 Live Bird Show**—First come, first served. Come learn about the Eastern screech owl and the red-tailed hawk with Crystal from the Virginia Aquarium! See these birds in action and learn about their habitat! Show approximately 20 minutes.
Shows at 1:00, 2:00, and 3:00.
- 19 What is an Osprey? Meet the Raptor Whisperer**—First come, first served. Meet Reese Lukei, local celebrity and volunteer Research Associate at The Center for Conservation Biology at the College of William & Mary, and learn about these beautiful birds of prey! Show approximately 15 minutes.
